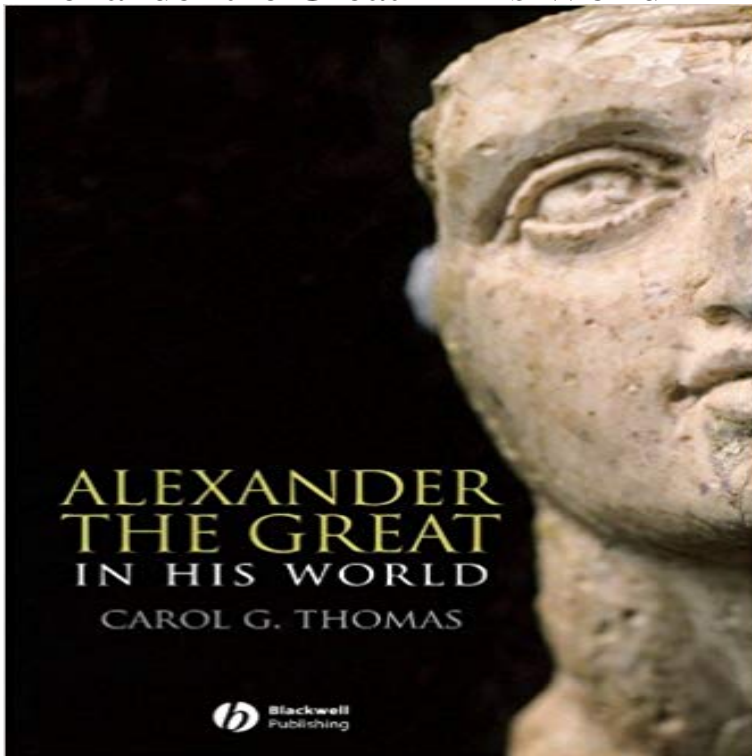


Alexander the Great in His World
