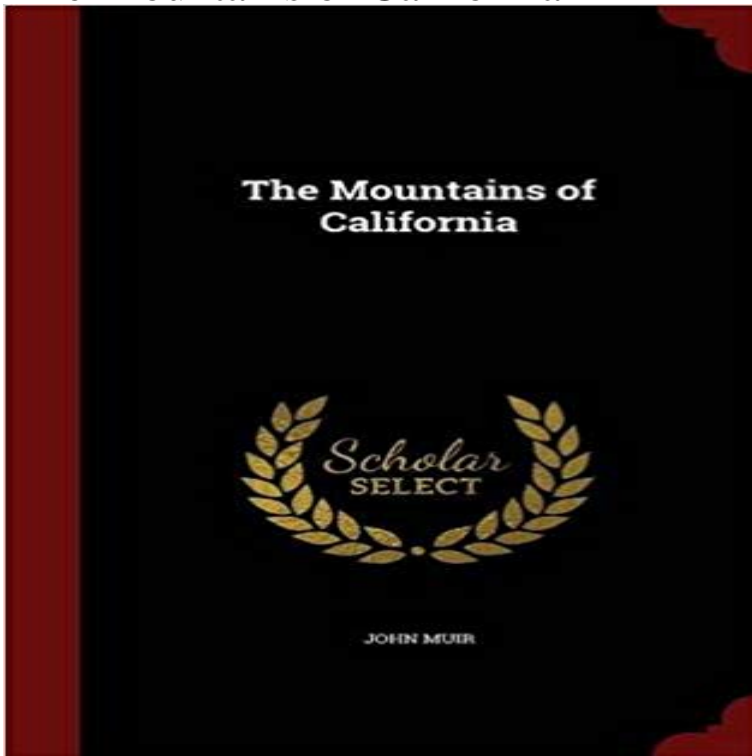


# The Mountains of California
