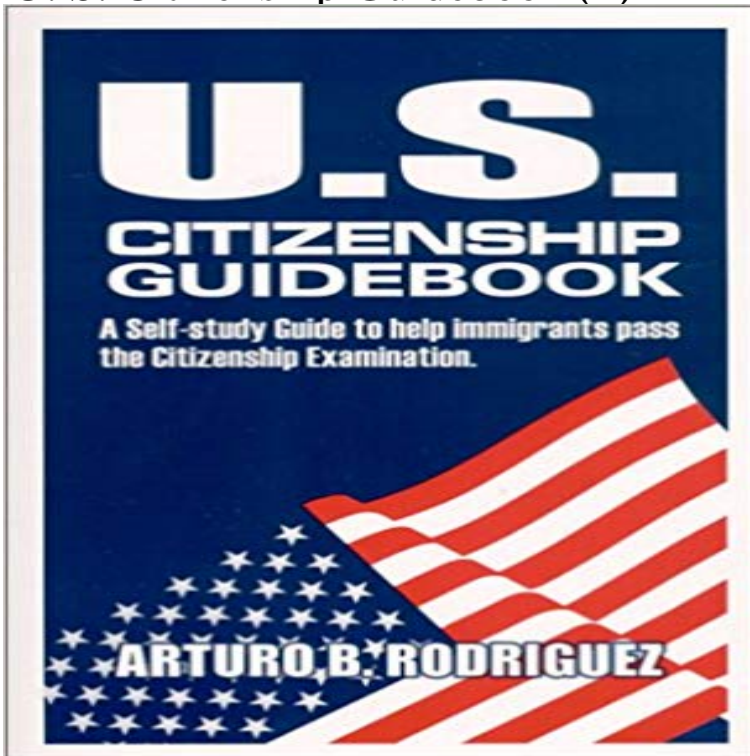


U. S. Citizenship Guidebook (1)
