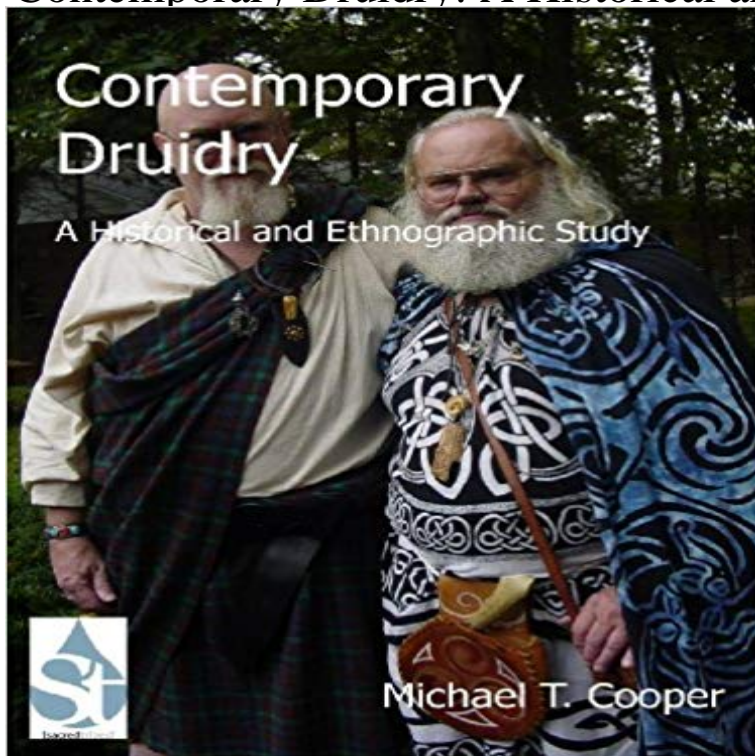


Contemporary Druidry: A Historical and Ethnographic Study
