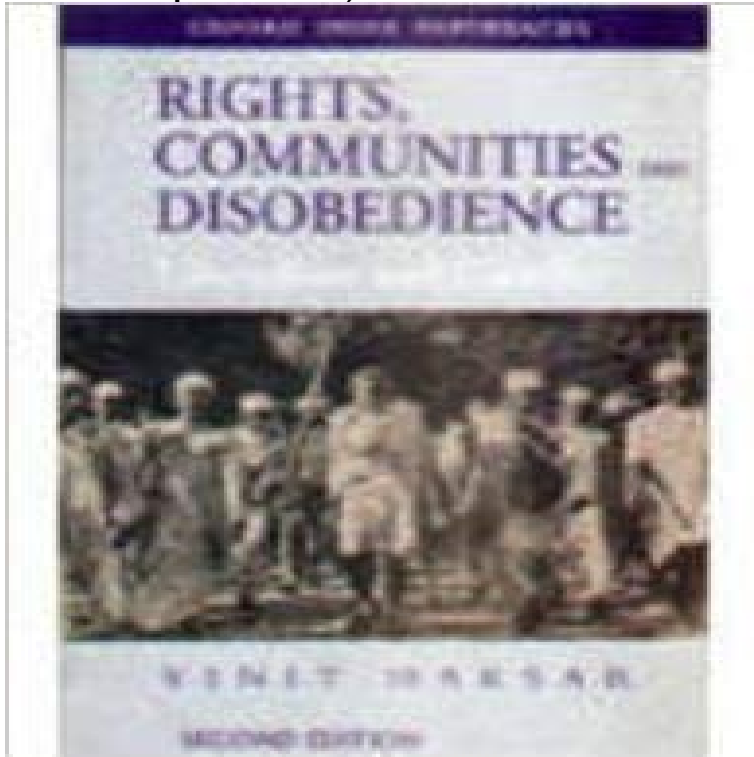


Rights, Communities, and Disobedience: Liberalism and Gandhi (Oxford India Paperbacks)
