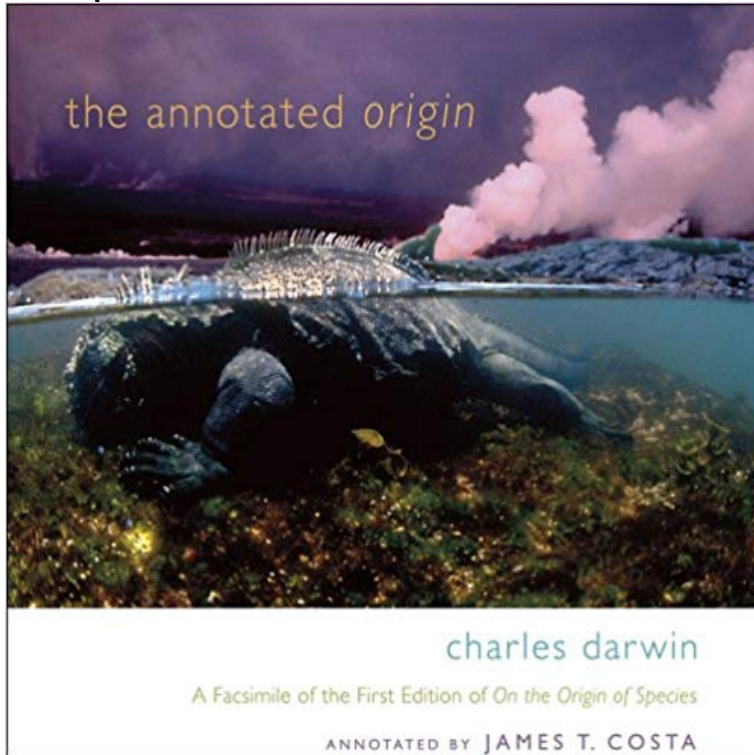


The Annotated Origin: A Facsimile of the First Edition of On the Origin of Species



Charles Darwin's *On the Origin of Species* is the most important and yet least read scientific work in the history of science. Now James T. This edition makes available an accessible, useful, and practical resource for anyone reading the *Origin* for the first time or for those who want to reread it with the insights and perspective that a working biologist can provide.
