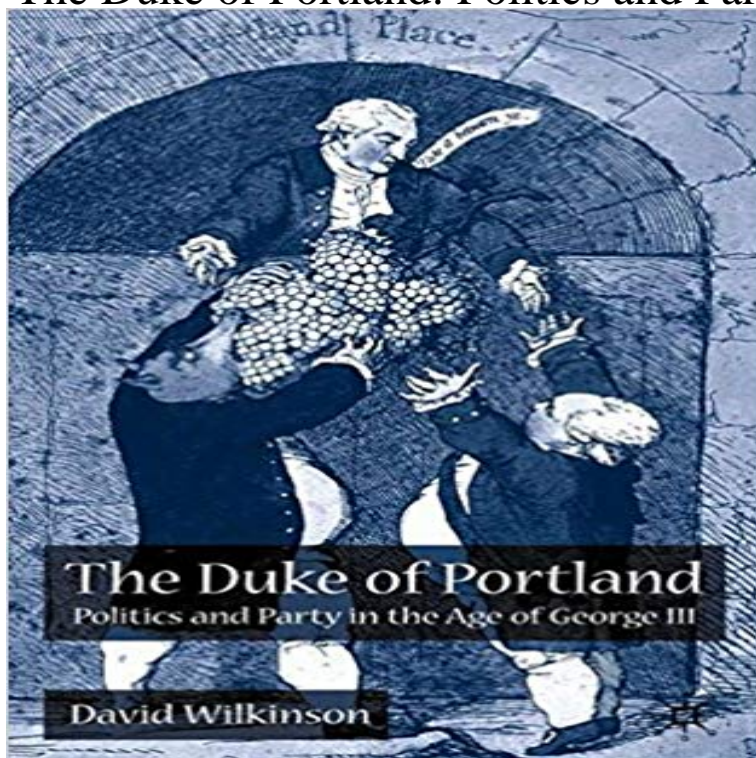


## The Duke of Portland: Politics and Party in the Age of George III



The Third Duke of Portland served twice as Prime Minister and had a long and distinguished political career from the 1760s to the 1780s.
