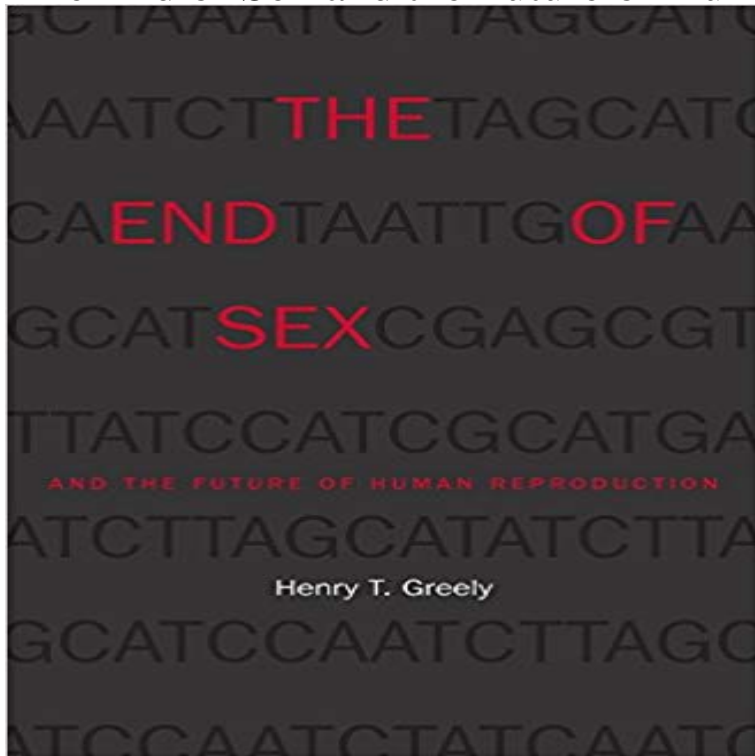


The End of Sex and the Future of Human Reproduction

The first child born using PGD is now 25 years old, and thousands more are born each year. Advanced by economic, social, legal, and political forces, the emerging science has made the concerns that were once the stuff of science fiction into real problems that our children and grandchildren will face routinely. Deeply informed by Greely's command of both science and law, *The End of Sex and the Future of Human Reproduction* is a book for parents, citizens, and all those, born and unborn, who will face the consequences of a new era of human reproduction.
