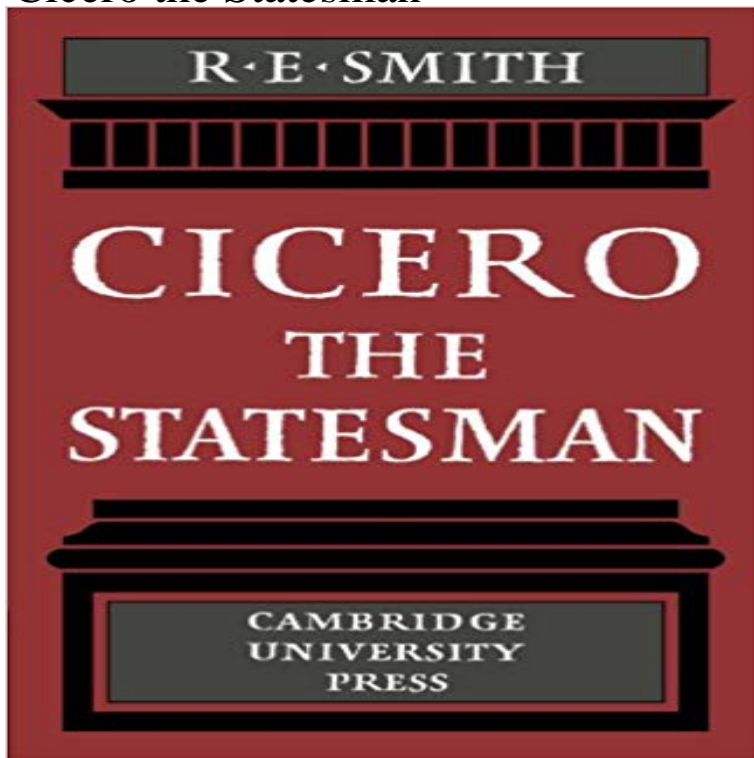


## Cicero the Statesman
