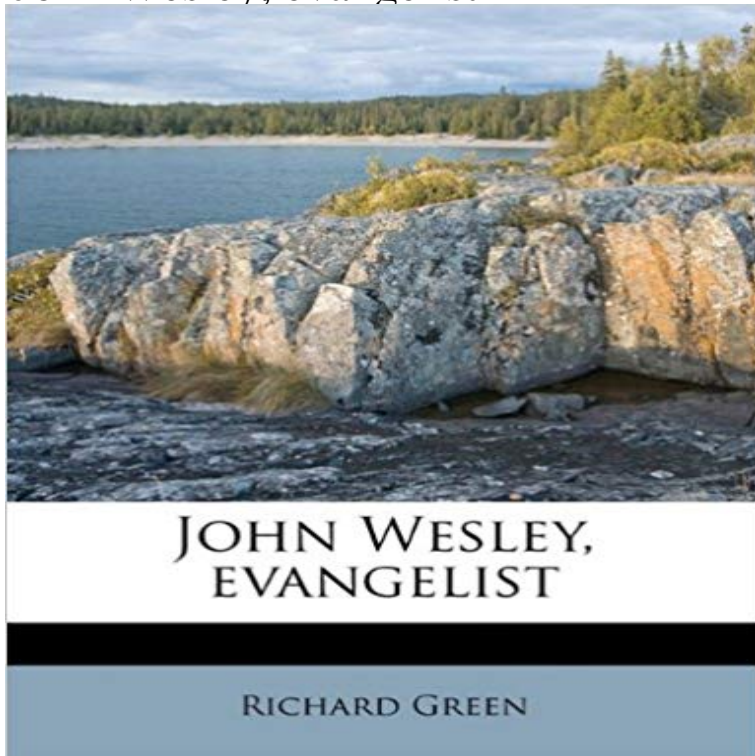


## John Wesley, evangelist
