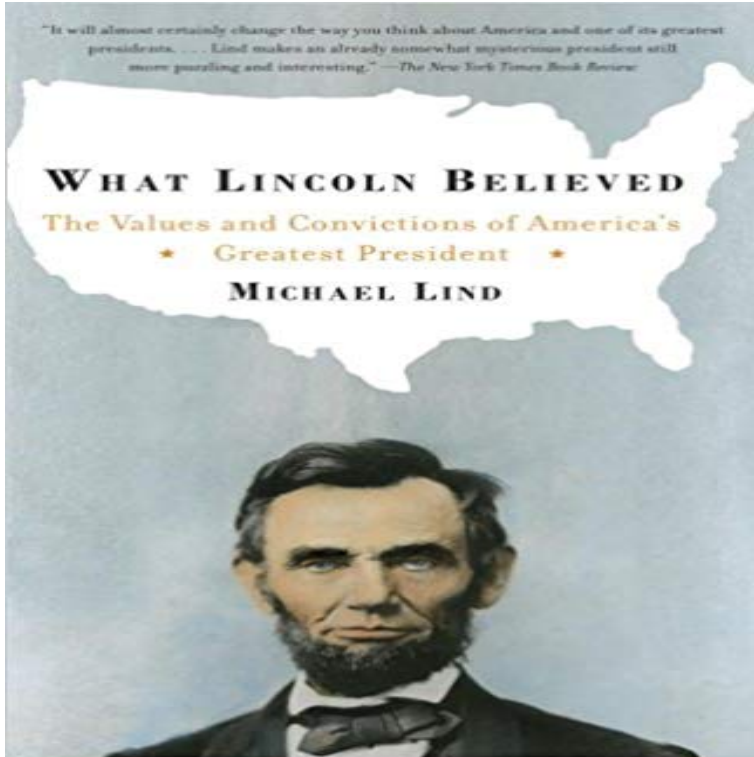


What Lincoln Believed: The Values and Convictions of Americas Greatest President

Challenging popular myths and capturing Lincoln's strengths and flaws, Lind offers fascinating and revelatory insights that deepen our understanding of this great and complicated man.
